REQUIREMENTS FOR PREPARATION OF ABSTRACTS OF REPORTS

Structure of Thesis:

- title (capital letters, bold type);

- number and name of the thematic direction;

- presenting author information: initials, surname: in bold, italics; in italics: the name of the institution of higher education – for each author; the name of the educational program (specialty) and the group – for students; position, scientific degree and academic title – for scientific and pedagogical workers.

- main text of thesis;

- list of references.

Volume of abstracts – up to 3 pages of A5 format.

Page margins: top, bottom, left and right -2.0 cm.

Mandatory computer typing in the Microsoft WORD text editor.

Font New Roman typeface, font size 11.

The line spacing is a factor of 0.9.

Paragraph margin -0.5 cm.

All schemes, figures and tables must have a title and numbering.

The authors confirm that the abstracts are their own work, carried out and designed in accordance with the principles of academic integrity. Authors agree to check the abstract for textual borrowing.
