### **REQUIREMENTS FOR PAPERS PREPARATION**

Abstracts (upto 3 pages) are prepared on the standard sheet of A5 paper as an .rtff file for Word for Windows. Font: TimesNewRomanCyr, size - 11, lead - 1.0; margins: right - 15 mm, left - 20 mm, top, bottom - 10 mm.

Tables in the text should be written in Excel or Word without filling. Formulas are typed in MS Equation 3.0 or MathType. Formula size: regular symbol - 11 pt, large index - 7 pt, small index - 5 pt, large symbol - 15 pt, small symbol - 9 pt. Formula style: variable - italics, matrix-vector - bold. Drawings, if they are made in Word, must be grouped together and represent a single graphic object.

Design: in the left corner - initials and surname of the author (bold, italics), academic degree and academic title (italics), below - place of work (italics), one line below the title of the report (in the middle of the line, all capital letters, bold); below one line there should be the text of the report. In the end, as a conclusion the scientific (practical) novelty stated in the report is formulated. The list of used sources is printed without a paragraph indent. Abstracts that do not meet the requirements will not be published.
